



Boating Speed Regulations:

Slow Speed Zone:
The area south of the hydroelectric dam in Taylors Falls/St. Croix Falls to the Arcola Sandbar at approximately mile 31.0 is a slow speed zone. Slow speed is operation of a motorboat at a leisurely speed, whereby the wake or wash created is minimal.

Slow-No Wake:
A slow-no wake rule is in effect whenever the Stillwater gauge exceeds 683 feet and in slow-no wake zones. Slow-no wake is also required within 100 feet of shore (including shores of islands) and swimmers, from Arcola Sandbar to the confluence of the St. Croix River with the Mississippi River. Slow-no wake speed is the slowest speed necessary to steer, no more than 5 mph.
